

## How to store plastic containers

Do you have trouble finding plastic containers and their lids? Learn how to order the kitchen to always have them at hand.



Plastic containers are very practical, but storing and organizing them in the kitchen can be a feat because sometimes you find the lid, but not the container that goes with it, it's like they magically disappear, has this happened to you? Keep reading and discover different recommendations so that you can maintain the order and good condition of the containers that you use so much.

Avoid moisture



After using detergent Powerful in Plastic that is special for the care of your containers, make sure that the containers and lids are completely dry before storing them. Consider the following tips to avoid bacteria, fungi and bad odors:

- Use a cloth or paper towel to dry them after washing to ensure they are not damp.
- Avoid storing them wet as mold and bad odors will take over them at any time.
- Use a cloth bag with rice to absorb moisture in the special cabinet for storing plastic containers.

Separate containers and lids



Once clean and dry, we recommend that you store the lids and containers separately to avoid bad odors. An incredible way to do it is by putting them in a separate larger plastic container or in an old dish drainer that you have stored and why not, even in a drawer with cardboard dividers. So, they will always be organized and at hand. Do not forget to leave a minimum space to allow air to circulate and ventilate.

Separate them by category



Separate the containers according to the use you give them, the size or material. There are some that you prefer to take to the office, others that are suitable for use in the microwave and others that are small to carry snacks in your bag.
